Year 11 Summer Internal Assessments

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your patience and support with our plan for determining year 11 grades this year. I would also like to commend Year 11 and their commitment to their studies since returning to us in person. In the face of uncertainty they never fail to impress us with their resilience and determination.

As previously communicated, and in line with OFQUAL guidance we will be using a variety of evidence to determine the final grade however we will give the greatest weight to work completed in Year 11 with the most significant evidence being internal assessments which completed under controlled conditions at school.

These assessments will be held in classrooms but please be assured that any student entitled to access arrangements will still receive these.

We can confirm that our Internal Assessment period will take place 10-28 May and you can find a link to the assessment timetable plus all the resources to help students prepare [here](#). I cannot stress enough the importance of attending school both during the preparation weeks and also during the assessment window to ensure our staff have a wide range of evidence that can be used to determine final grades. If students are absent for any assessment, we have built in catch up sessions to ensure they are still able to complete their assessment.


